Dear Customer:

Thank you for your use and interest in DensDefy™ Transition Membrane distributed by GP Gypsum.

The DensDefy Transition Membrane is considered to be an article as defined by the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard and, therefore, exempt from the safety data sheet (SDS) requirements of that standard.

Section 1910.1200 (c), Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulations specifically states that its Hazard Communication section does not apply to “articles” in paragraph (b) (6) (v). An article is defined as follows:

c) Definitions. Article means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.

Despite such exemption, please note the following in connection with the DensDefy Transition Membrane:

**Product Handling & Use:**

Observe good industrial hygiene practices. Wash hands after handling. Store in a cool, dry place away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames, and other ignition sources. Store away from strong oxidizing agents. Dispose of waste and residues in accordance with local authority requirements.
